

CHESTERMERE HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP

Dear Graduate:

The Chestermere High School Scholarship Fund was started in 1978 by a student, Carolyn Tester, and the first scholarship was awarded in the fall of 1979. Carolyn found that there were no scholarships available for students capable of, and willing to, further their education but didn't necessarily have high enough grades to qualify for some of the existing scholarships.

The objective was to establish a scholarship account through fundraising and donations with \$10,000 as the initial goal, so that the interest earned on this principle could be used for the award. Thanks to donations, the principle now sits at \$15,000.

The Scholarship Committee is made up of 5 community members and a school representative. This committee decides on the recipient or recipients, and the amount of the award or awards.

Application forms (available from the guidance office) are to be submitted by September 1st of the graduating year, along with proof of registration at a post-secondary school and transcripts from Grades 10, 11 and 12. Applicants must have attended Chestermere High School and have obtained at least 45 credits at Chestermere High School. On years when there are no applicants, graduates from that year may apply the following year.

The scholarships will be awarded on the basis of academic proficiency, extracurricular involvement, citizenship, leadership and financial need.
